Early identification of needs

Communication with parents



- High quality focused interventions
- Groups targets for interventions
- TAs trained to lead interventions
- Interventions evaluated to ensure they are effective

Interventions matched to the child's needs



- Referrals to outside agencies when needed (education or health services)
- Classroom adaptations
- Curriulum adaptations
- Pupil Outcome Plans (POPs)

Individualised support



- Teacher assessment identified children having difficulties
- Effective deployment of staff
- Individualised strategies used
- Monitoring and evaluation of teaching
