







Year 6 and Keyworker children

**Year 6, Year 1
Reception
Keyworker children**

Only keyworker children and those in Reception, year 1 and year 6 can come in to school.

Nursery, Years 2, 3, 4 and 5 need to stay at home

Children will be put into small groups of up to 6 children. They will be in school part time.

Year 6 - Mornings from 9.15 until 11.45

To be dropped off and collected from the playground

Year 1 - Afternoons from 1.15 until 3.15

To be dropped off and collected from the playground

Reception - Afternoons from 1.15 until 3.15

To be dropped off and collected from Nursery playground

Keyworker 9.00am until 3.00am

To be dropped off and collected from the playground

Please make sure you are on time to drop off and collect your child / children. Gates will only be open for 5 minutes at the start and end of each session.

Children who are late will not be admitted to school.

This is so that we can maintain strict social distancing to protect adults and children.
