- 8/10 children from each class attend the club at any one time.

## Protocol for organising groups and setting up sessions.

1. At the start of the year, class teachers in $\mathrm{Y} 1,3$ and 5 to split their classes in to groups of $8(\mathrm{Y} 3)$ or $10(\mathrm{Y} 1, \mathrm{Y} 5)$.
2. Permission slip to be sent to parents two weeks prior to group starting. If permission is not granted child will not be able to attend.
3. Forest School sessions run over a 6 week period.
4. The next group begins their sessions immediately after.

Equipment provided by the school and weather dependent wear the children will need.
Activities and their benefits.
Snack and juice.
Collection details.
