

### English in the DSP – units and texts

Our Designated Specialist Provision (DSP) for children with Communication and Interaction Needs including Autism, follows a language rich curriculum. The children experience a range of texts through sensory stories where a range of props are used to support the text and engage the children in a variety of ways. We adapt the written text using Widgeit symbols and use Makaton signs to support the retelling of the stories at the children’s ability levels. The children then carry out a range of activities to aid their academic progress as well as working towards their individual outcomes identified on their Education Health Care Plans.





