Respect and tolerance – what do we do?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PHSE lessons throughout school • No Outsiders and texts • Whole school assemblies celebrating different cultures, beliefs and festivals • RE curriculum • Celebration days e.g. Diwali Day, Easter Bonnet Parade, Remembrance • Timetabled visits to places of worship and visits from religious leaders • Diverse and representative texts studied through the curriculum • Character Traits – respectful is a key trait • Certificates in assembly – celebrating behaviour • Happy Lunchtimes – valuing traits and rewarding examples of showing respect • Mental Health Week • Black History Month • Charitable fundraising e.g. Comic Relief, Macmillan • DSP inclusion with mainstream / reverse inclusion • Art – appreciation • Music – appreciation of music from different cultures • Music – respecting others' performances • Computing – Online Safety • PE – team games and sportsmanship
